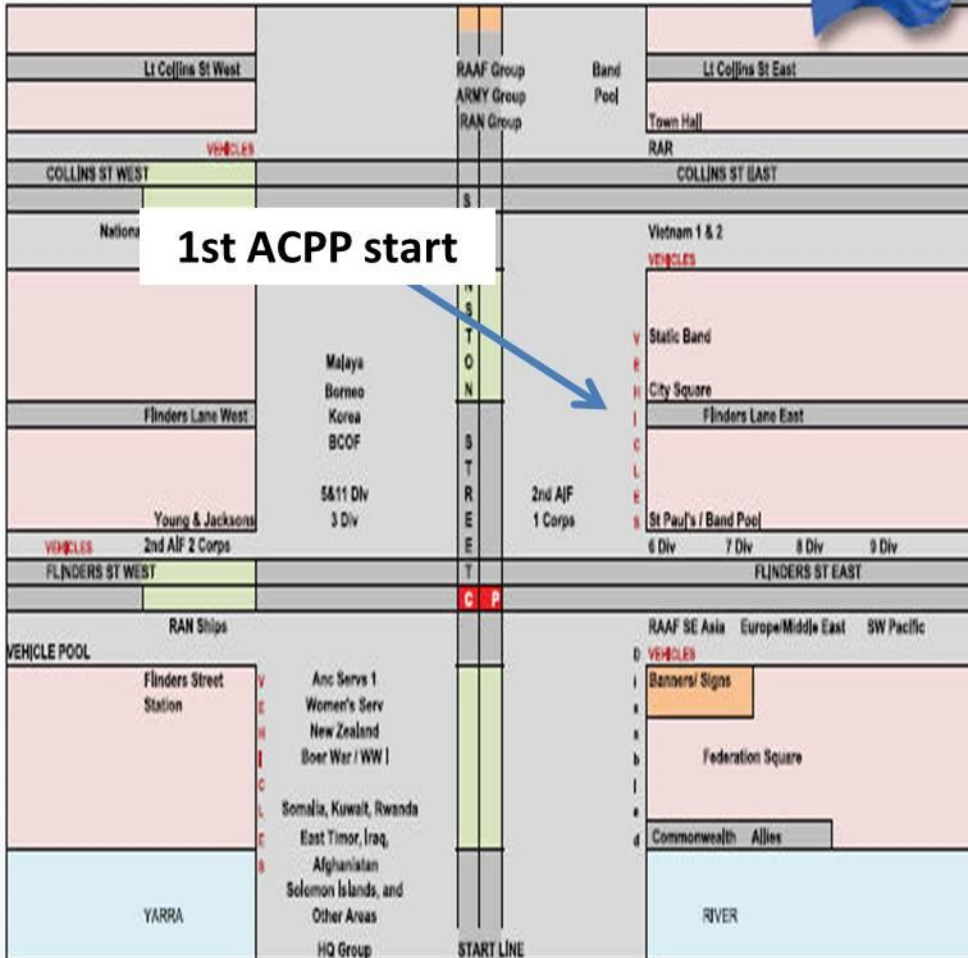


Map showing where we start from.
